The Victoria Foundation is delighted to have awarded grants of over £37,000 towards two new accessible minibuses which will make such an enormous difference to so many for years to come.



The Foundation awarded a grant of £20,000 towards a new 16 seat accessible minibus for Richmond and Kingston Accessible Community Transport. The minibus will provide hundreds of journeys for the elderly each year helping to prevent loneliness and isolation.



The Victoria Foundation awarded a grant of £17,707 to match funds Clarendon School, a Special Academy in the London Borough of Richmond-Upon-Thames, had available so that the school could purchase a much needed new 17 seat lightweight accessible minibus.

This grant was possible due to the support of so many, including the proceeds of the live auction at TVF's ball in 2021! We are all so relieved the minibus has finally arrived and the youngsters with complex needs are enjoying social and educational outings which are helping them to gain greater independence.

As discussed, this was allocated towards the purchase of three mobility aids. Specifically standing frames for students with profound and multiple disabilities who are part of The Garwood Foundation, based in Croydon.

The standing frames are be custom-built to suit the individual needs of each student, with adjustments made to ensure maximum comfort and safety.

The pupils at the Garwood Foundation spend their entire day in wheelchairs and require the use of Standing Frames to stretch their bodies and alleviate pressure.

TVF awarded a grant of £149 to fund a walking aid for an eighty-six-year-old lady who has rheumatoid arthritis. Due to there not being a seat or bench nearby or at the bus stop, she couldn't get to places as she can't stand comfortably for any length of time. An economy walker with a built-in seat will enable her to attend friends' houses, Age UK Twickenham, wellbeing RUILS activities, to get out and about and to be independent.
